



2016/17 Locals Ski Program

Adaptive Ski and Snowboard lessons for Deschutes County residents offered at discounted rates on specific dates throughout the season. The goal of this program is to increase consistency and accessibility of skiing to Deschutes County residents with disabilities.

Program Guidelines:

- Participants must pick the same day each week.
- Participants can sign up for a “lesson” or “ski buddy” experience.
- Program is available January 3rd - March 23rd, weekend availability is limited to the dates listed below.
- Registration for this program closes December 15th.
- Lessons are available for locals outside of this program, but participants will be asked to pay list rate or apply for a scholarship.

Cost:

Lessons: \$75/full day; \$40/half day (includes lift pass, all equipment, and instructor(s))

Buddy: \$40/full day; \$25/half day (includes lift pass, adaptive equipment (not rentals), and buddy(s))
