

## Oregon Adaptive Sports 2017/18 Locals Ski Program



After a successful inaugural year of the Central Oregon Local's Ski Program, OAS is excited to offer these opportunities once again.

Adaptive Ski and Snowboard lessons for Central Oregon residents offered at discounted rates on specific dates throughout the season at Mt Bachelor. The goal of this program is to increase consistency and accessibility of skiing to Central Oregon residents with disabilities.

### **Program Guidelines:**

- This program is for "lessons" only, ski buddies should book through our regular booking process.
- Participants must pick the same day each week – this is to create better consistency with OAS coaches.
- Program is available January 3<sup>rd</sup> - March 23<sup>rd</sup>
- Program is unavailable during the Blackout Dates listed below.
- Greatest availability is Monday, Wednesday, Saturday or Sunday.
- Registration for this program closes December 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Lessons are available for locals outside of this program, but participants will be asked to pay list rate or apply for a scholarship.

### **Cost:**

Lessons: \$75/full day; \$55/half day (includes lift pass, all equipment, and instructor)
